In November 2025 the Eswatini government granted a 20-year licence for a thermal coal power station and mine on 4,000ha at Lubhuku, in a water-stressed region that abuts the Lubombo Biosphere Reserve, part of the Lubombo Transfrontier Conservation and Resource Area. The Lubhuku Power Station in Mpaka, Lubombo Region, is set to begin operation in 2026 with an initial capacity of 150 MW, increasing to 300 MW by 2028. The plant will use coal from local deposits, such as Maloma Coal Mine, which is expected to last 30 years.
