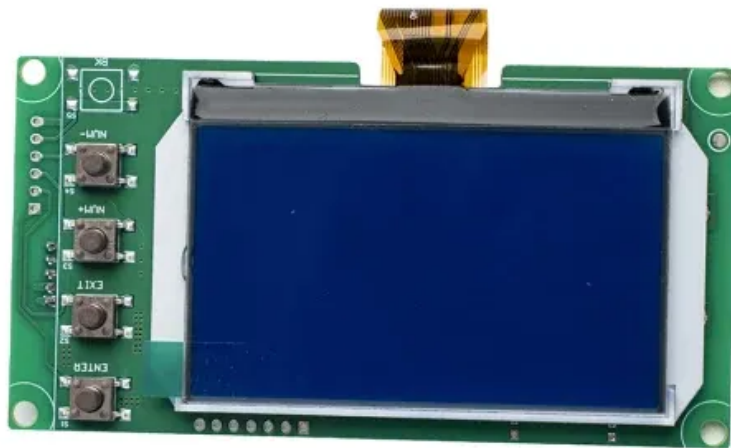

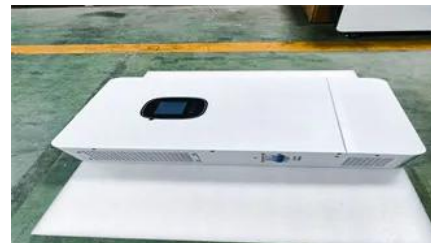


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Solar panel

How Does Solar Work?

When the sun shines onto a solar panel, energy from the sunlight is absorbed by the PV cells in the panel. This energy creates electrical charges that move in response to an internal electrical field in



Solar explained

PV cells and panels produce the most electricity when they are directly facing the sun. PV panels and arrays can use tracking systems to keep the panels facing the sun, but these systems are expensive.

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
