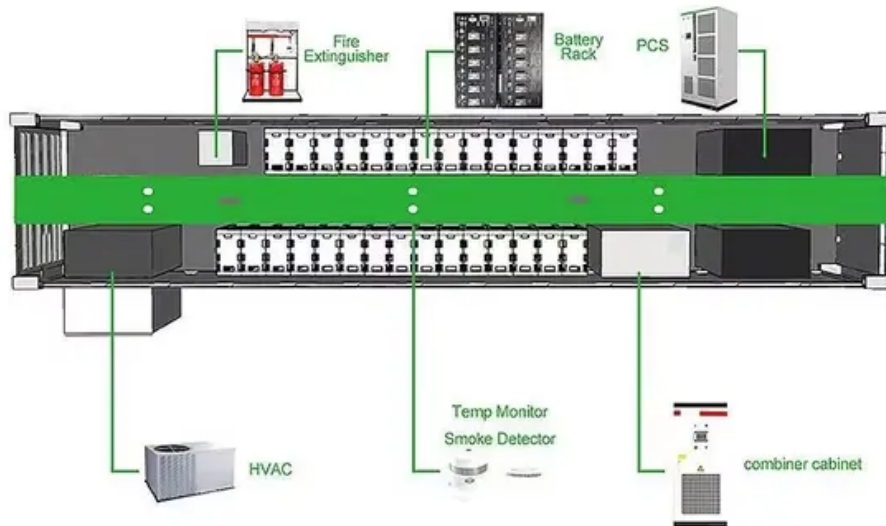


Electric vehicle policy italy

Italy has introduced a new round of state-backed incentives to encourage the adoption of electric vehicles, offering up to €11,000 for private buyers and €20,000 for small businesses purchasing fully electric models. The Ecobonus scheme has been refinanced for 2026. Registration .
