

Havana electricity generation



Overview

Havana suffers blackouts due to a power generation deficit that reaches 220 MW, impacting all six blocks of the city. This situation is due to a structural crisis in the Cuban electrical system, characterized by outdated equipment, lack of maintenance, and fuel shortages. In practice, except for prioritized areas, almost the entire city is without service at this time. President Donald Trump said earlier in the week . In September 2025, the island's national grid collapsed once again, leaving the country in darkness for hours. The problem stems from years of neglect of Cuba's energy infrastructure, exacerbated by constrained access .
