The country has no formal landline telephone network, and telecommunications services are provided through satellite and mobile communications networks. Various large international mobile phone providers are present in the country. Despite this progress, South Sudan remains one of the least connected countries globally, with limited infrastructure, high costs, and significant rural-urban disparities in access.
