

How does China rank in photovoltaic panels



Overview

China is the largest market in the world for both photovoltaics (PV) and solar thermal energy. Its PV capacity crossed 1,000 gigawatts (one terawatt, 1 TW) in May 2025. Photovoltaic systems are by far the more common and versatile of the two. Rapid solar capacity expansion overwhelms the grid, PV manufacturers compete for market shares, and then large target markets slap import tariffs on Chinese PV products, taking off their competitive edge. According to Enerdata, the top 25 manufacturers increased their combined shipments . In the latest consolidated data, global PV module production reached 726 GW and manufacturing capacity reached 1,405 GW/year, with 83% of capacity located in China. 10/W from late May 2024 - a sign of intense oversupply and margin . IEA PVPS has released the latest National Survey Report of PV Power Applications in China 2024, prepared by Task 1 with data from the National Energy Administration (NEA) and the China Photovoltaic Industry Association (CPIA).
