According to the Betz Limit, proposed by German physicist Albert Betz in 1919, no turbine can capture more than 59.3% of the kinetic energy from the wind, because some energy must remain in the airflow to allow it to continue moving past the blades. As the air rotates and goes up, the pressure at the bottom of the vortex becomes lower. As surrounding air enters at the bottom, and the difference in pressures then drives a turbine
