Overview

In 2021, the majority of Iraq's electricity consumption was attributed to the residential sector, which used 65.6%, and industrial activities at 11. - Iraq's Energy & Climate Policy Framework: Iraq aims for 33% renewable energy in its power mix by 2030, with the Ministry of Electricity overseeing sector modernisation. The oil-dependent economy is diversifying under the Integrated National Energy Strategy (INES), while OPEC+ agreements cap .
