The "Electrification of Kiribati's Line Islands Powered through Solar Energy" (EKLIPSE) project, launched in mid-2024, aims to enhance power security by integrating solar energy with batteries to reduce reliance on diesel generators. With rising fuel costs and environmental concerns, this Pacific archipelago is turning to renewable energy solutions that work with its unique geography. Kiribati faces three critical power issues: "Our communities need power systems that survive typhoons and salt spray," says a local project . 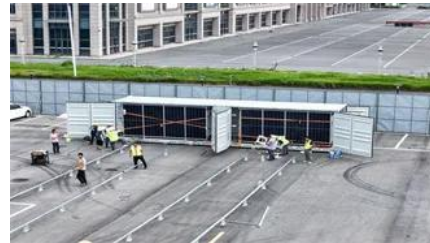

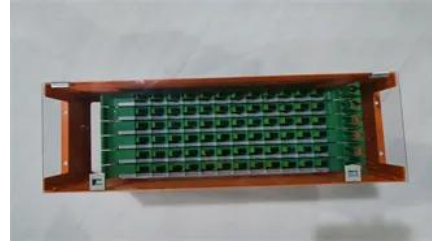
