

Kyrgyzstan electric vehicle charging infrastructure



Overview

More than 230 charging stations operate throughout the country, including approximately 60 in Bishkek. However, further scaling of the infrastructure requires clear institutional coordination, improved regulatory frameworks, and the introduction of predictable permitting . According to him, international experience shows that scaling charging infrastructure requires clear regulations, long-term planning, and effective public-private partnerships.
