Overview

Namibia's government incentives are rooted in a long-term economic strategy known as Vision 2030. The Ministry of Mines and Energy (MME) is the sole administrator of the Solar Revolving Fund (SRF). The SRF is a credit facility established by MME to stimulate demand for the utilization of renewable energy technologies in the rural areas, especially for communities living in off-grid areas, but . This natural endowment along with a need for Namibia to reduce its dependence on electricity imports and minimise negative impacts from fossil fuel-heavy energy supply has historically incentivised the government to increase the country's share of renewable energy. Currently, almost 300,000 . The Green People's Energy (GPE) used the results-based financing (RBF) approach to support 44 rural businesses and farmers in Namibia to acquire decentralized renewable energy systems for productive use. With a N\$140 million subsidy allocation, equivalent to around \$7.
