In Guyana, solar energy is used for several purposes, including drying agricultural produce, irrigation, ICT, and to improve electricity access in rural areas. Under the Hinterland Electrification Programme, in excess of 19,000 solar PV systems had been installed in nearly 200 communities by 2018. In a recent interview with The New York Times, Guyana's President Irfaan Ali made bold claims about his country's commitment to a clean energy transition, funded by its newfound oil wealth. The GUY SOL initiative, funded by the Guyana/Norway partnership with an estimated investment of US\$83.3 million, aims to diversify . The general objective of the program is to support the diversification of Guyana's energymatrix towards the use of climate-resilient renewable energy sources in the electricity generation matrix. The specific objectives of the program are to: (i) avoid CO₂ emissions with the development of solar . In a decisive move towards sustainable development, the Government of Guyana has launched a state-of-the-art solar farm on Wakenaam Island, Region Three-an initiative poised to redefine its energy landscape and catalyze economic growth. The Trafalgar Solar Farm was constructed at an estimated cost of US\$8 million, fully financed through the Guyana-Norway climate partnership, under the Guyana REDD+ Investment Fund, administered by the Inter-American Development Bank (Office of the Prime Minister photos) -with commissioning of 4MWp .
